




Follow the instructions to make a paper pinwheel. Remember to be careful with the scissors and the pushpin. You will need a paper sheet, a pencil with an




1. Grab a square paper. You can colour or decorate one side.




2. Fold the paper diagonally to the left first.




3. And then fold it diagonally to the right.




4. Unfold the paper, you will see a pleated X right through it.




5. Using a coin, draw a circle in the middle and cut on the pleats until you reach it.




6. Take the corner to the center, without pushing it down.



7. Do the same thing with all four corners, and put the pushpin in the middle.



8. Push the tip of the pushpin to the eraser of a pencil.
