


Today we will make some beautiful art paintings using Magic Milk! Get ready to enjoy this fun activity!!!




1. Put a layer of milk on your plate, and then add some colour drops all through.




2. Dip the tip of your swab on the liquid soap and watch closely! Milk will start swirling and running, almost dancing!



3. Get more soap to react with the milk and the food colouring. The more you add, the more it moves!



4. Once you have a nice mixture of marbled colours, get ready to "print" your art!



5. Grab a square of paper steadily with both hands (absorbing side facing down) and place it on the surface.



6. Turn it around, let it dry, and sign it like an artist!
