




Today we will make a beautiful lantern to commemorate the beginning of Ramadan. You can make as many lanterns as you wish, and hang them as decorations at home.




1. On a rectangular paper or cardstock, cut out a strip for the handle.



2. Set the strip aside and fold the rectangle in half.




3. Draw a line as your top and base guide.




4. Draw equally-spaced lines for cutting shortly.



5. Cut the lines until the guide line, as shown in the picture.




6. Unfold it, and then wrap it round, put a bit of tape to join both sides together.



7. Add the handle to the top strip, using a piece of tape to secure it.



8. You can decorate the lantern with moons and stars. Ramadan Mubarak!
